TMMC produced **533,566** Toyota and Lexus vehicles in 2024.

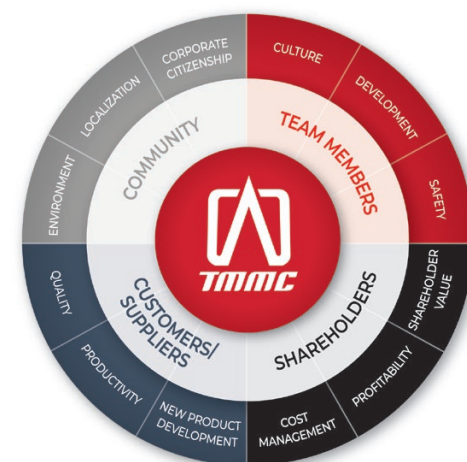
- ▶ **1985** Announced Toyota is building a plant in Cambridge, Ontario
 - ▶ **1988** First car, a four-door Corolla sedan, rolls off the line
 - ▶ **1997** Major expansion - North Plant begins production, doubling employment and manufacturing capacity
 - ▶ **2003** TMMC becomes first plant outside of Japan to manufacture Lexus vehicles
 - ▶ **2008** TMMC's Woodstock plant begins producing RAV4s
 - ▶ **2014** First hybrid, a Lexus RX 450h, rolls off the line
 - ▶ **2022** Lexus NX and NX Hybrid production begins at TMMC's North Plant
 - ▶ **2024** TMMC manufactures its 11,000,000th vehicle
